



Polska Federacja Squasha

Squash European Nations Challenge Cup (ENCC) is a team tournament for European states, in which squash is being developed as a sports discipline. The following countries are eligible to present their teams: Norway, Lithuania, Lichtenstein, Latvia, Estonia, Malta, Gibraltar, Turkey, Isle of Man, Ukraine, Belorussia, Russia, Croatia, Serbia, Slovakia, Slovenia, Portugal, Monaco, Moldova, Luxembourg, Iceland, Hungary, Greece, Cyprus, Bulgaria and Poland. The cup has been organized since 2003. It was hosted in turns by Slovakia, Slovenia, Estonia, Poland, Latvia and Hungary.

The seventh edition of the cup will be held on 1-3 October 2009 in the SquashPark centre in the city of Poznan and there will be 13 male and 8 female teams participating.

The Polish representation won its first victory on this international tournament in 2003, when the male team came in third. The Polish teams waited for their next successes till 2006 and 2008 when the female representation won the silver medal and in 2007 the Ladies came in third in the cup.
